Based on 30 names per page, however, the total number of inhabitants is probably 821.

Transcribed from *Revista del Archivo y Biblioteca Nacionales* (1945-1949), which in turn was copied from the *Gaceta Municipal de Tegucigalpa* (1923-1926). The whereabouts of the original census is not known.
